

Group Trips To Orlando

Walt Disney World is one of our most popular requests. Lots of families travel there on their own but many families prefer the security and support of a group trip.

We currently organise a group trip to Orlando once a year, usually at the beginning of May. Each group consists of around 45 people made up of approximately 12 dream children and their families, two group leaders (members of staff from Dreams Come True) and two Paediatric nurses.

The advantages of travelling with a group trip are:

- A pre-arranged itinerary.
- No transport worries as everything has been pre-arranged.
- Staff and nurses on hand to help and advise.
- An opportunity for you and your child/children to make new friends.
- Particularly good for parents travelling on their own with children or for families who have never travelled before.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

The holiday package is booked through Virgin Holidays.

Dreams Come True will cover the cost for **the dream child plus one adult carer** for:

- Return flights from London Gatwick to Orlando, Florida.
- Overnight accommodation at Gatwick the night before departure.
- 9 nights accommodation at the Rosen Inn at Pointe Orlando on International Drive, (a photo and description of the hotel can be found in the 'Virgin Florida' brochure).
- Coach travel to the hotel and various venues.
- 5 days theme park tickets.
- Food allowance.
- Insurance for your child plus one adult carer.

We have a fixed itinerary which consists of visiting two Disney parks; Magic Kingdom and Animal Kingdom, plus Universal Studios, Islands of Adventure and Legoland.

In addition to this there is a half-day visit to one of the Shopping Malls and two rest days where you are free to do your own thing.

Please Note:

- The flight is around 9-10 hours long so please consider whether or not your child will manage this.
- The group trip happens every May.
- Places are reserved on a first come first served basis. (Spaces tend to get filled up to six months beforehand.)
- Other family members are very welcome to join you on the trip but you will need to meet their costs.
- The May 2017 Group Trip is full. The next available Group Trip will be May 2018.
